What your child will need:

Our school already provides many materials for our students to use, but we ask that you send your child in with the following:

- Backpack and lunchbox
- 1 plastic folder with inside pockets
- 1 pack of construction paper*
- Towel or small blanket for rest time (small pillow can be sent in too)
- 1 box of tissues*

(No smaller than 6.5 inches by 9 inches. Make sure it is able to stay open easily on its own.)
- * 7 pocket folders (1 of each red, blue, green, purple, white, black, yellow), preferably plastic. Labeled as follows:
1 red labeled Math, 1 blue labeled Home, 1 green labeled Reading, 1 purple labeled Science, 1 orange labeled Wait Time, 1 black labeled Writing, 1 yellow labeled Social Studies.
- * Fabric pencil pouch equipped with:
 - pencils (Not mechanical)
 - erasable pens
 - eraser caps
 - handheld pencil sharpener
- * 1 box of presharpened pencils
These will be collected for whole class use
- * 1 set of headphones (for personal use during in-school computer activities)
- * Colorful dry erase markers - thick and thin sizes (for class use)
